### TRAFFIC BLOCKED.

While an east-bound T., H. & B. freight train en route to Welland was nearing Coyle station about 6.30 last night three cars left the rails and piled up in such a manner as to completely block traffic for several hours. The train was in charge of Conductor Finch, and was not running at high speed, otherwise the accident might have resulted more seriously. The wrecking crew was sent out to clear the tracks. In the meantime, regular traffic was diverted via Waterford and the M. C. R. No one was injured.
