### C.P.R. Mattawa-Angliers Service

Announcement was made by H. C. James, General Passenger Agent, C.P.R., December 12, of the inauguration of passenger train service, daily except Sunday, between Mattawa, Ont., and Angliers, Que., serving those terminal points and Timiskaminc, Ville Marie and other places in this fast-developing area of Northwestern Quebec.
