Brantford, Norfolk and Port Burwell R.

BRANTFORD, Nov. 12.—The ceremony of depositing an urn containing a parchment with the names of the newspapers of the town and county, statistics of the Brantford, Norfolk and Port Burwell Railroad, and number of the local and provincial newspapers, in the eastern abutment of the new railway bridge, took place. The Mayor, the chief magistrate of the town, performed the ceremony of making the deposit. The names of the newspapers contained in the urn are *THE GLOBE, Mail, Leader, Illustrated News, Expositor, Courier and Union*. The parchment sets off that the tablet this day erected in the railway bridge over the Grand River is "to commemorate the turning of the first sod of the Brantford, Norfolk and Port Burwell Railway by the Earl of Dufferin, K. P., K. C. B., Governor-General of the Dominion of Canada, on the 24th day of August, in the year of our Lord 1874."
