

Magdalen River Valley Ry.—C. W. Mullen, S. W. Harriman, Bangor, Me.; C. D. Loring, Boston, Mass.; J. O. Drouin, E. Brassard, Montreal, were last session of the Quebec Legislature given an act incorporating a company with this title, with office at Quebec, and power to construct a railway from Lamorneville to the east of Cap a la Cruz, Gaspé county, along the Magdalen River valley, to connect with the proposed inland section of the Atlantic Quebec and Western Ry.
