St. Polycarpe Jct. Joint Facilities. —

Notice was given by the Canadian National Ry. Co., on Dec. 18, 1925, that, at the expiration of a month from Dec. 26, 1925, it would apply to the Board of Railway Commissioners, under the Railway Act, 1919, sec. 154, for a recommendation by the Board to the Governor in council to sanction an agreement entered into between the Canadian National and the Canadian Pacific Ry. Cos., providing for the joint use by them of the station and certain other facilities at St. Polycarpe Jct., Que., (now De Beaujeu), for 20 years from May 1, 1922. St. Polycarpe Jct., as the station is still named in the latest time tables to hand, is on the Canadian National's Montreal-Ottawa line, formerly Canada Atlantic Ry., 44 miles from Montreal, and 6.92 miles from Coteau towards Ottawa. On the Canadian Pacific's Montreal-Toronto line it is 40.2 miles from Montreal.
