### UXBRIDGE.

#### Round-House Burned.

Uxbridge, Jan. 13.—This morning between  
1 and 2 the alarm of fire was given, the  
roundhouse of the Midland Railway Company,  
in which four locomotives were enclosed, having  
been discovered in flames. The firemen were de-  
layed for a short time on account of no water, it  
being shut off at Mr. Gould's mill dam, but after  
some little difficulty they managed to get a small  
stream to play on the surrounding buildings, it  
being evident that they could not save the round-  
house. The loss is estimated at \$50,000. The  
building is said to be insured to a certain extent.
