The annual meetings of shareholders of the Grand River Ry. Co. and the Lake Erie and Northern Ry. Co. were held in Montreal, April 17, with H. J. Humphrey, Vice President, Eastern Lines, C.P.R., and President of both the Grand River Ry. Co. and Lake Erie and Northern Ry. Co., presiding. Reports for 1942 recorded that gross earnings of both companies had increased considerably, and that net earnings had improved in satisfactory manner over those of 1941. Further increase in traffic during 1943 is anticipated.
