I am a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) and have been providing counseling services to domestic violence survivors at the Casa Seguras, from February 2008 to the present day. Casa Seguras is an emergency shelter for victims of domestic violence with South Bay Community Services. We provide confidential shelter to women and children. During clients' participation in Casa Seguras, clients are offered case management services, individual and group counseling services.
