

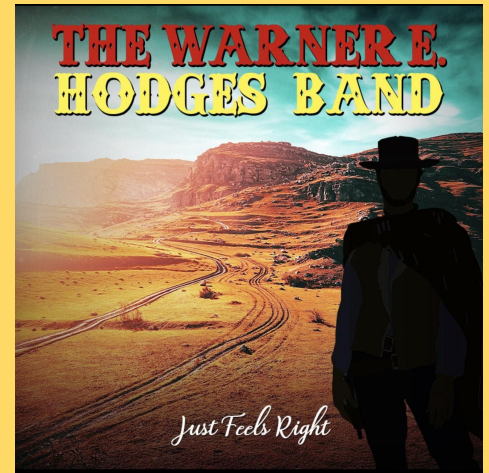

**Just Feels Right:** This one is a homage to my R & R and Country roots. Exactly what you would expect from me.

**The Magician:** Flat out country song about life in the bottle. Absolutely in my roots and DNA.

**Where You Gone:** Fun Look at a love. Guitar city.

**Company Man:** Good ole folk rock.

**Higher Ground:** Once again, a tip of the hat to one of my heroes, Little Richard. I have always loved that 'vibe' on his songs. We tried to get as close as possible to that feel.

**Nickel And Dimin':** Obviously, I Love AC/DC y'all! They have heavily influenced my playing. Just good time Rock And Roll.

**In Your Dreams:** Very country rock, Bakersfield look at a romance that's best while she sleeps!

**Don't Bring Me Down:** Kinda snarky commentary on where I've been, and where I'm going. Big old R & R song.

**Take Me Downtown:** Started out as a weird chord that Dan Baird found on his guitar. Then it went through the filter, and came out as an ode to Jeff Beck and Jimmy Page. Not a bad one-two combo if ya ask me.

**Callin' Me Home:** Our take on folk music for the people. Live in the studio y'all.
