The Cartoon Jazz Band (CJB) first blew onto the scene in 2003 at the Stanford Jazz Festival. Band Leader Jeff Sanford revived the music of great American composer Raymond Scott with rediscovered arrangements for a 16-piece big band. Over the years, CJB members have contributed new arrangements, and Jeff has commissioned original compositions especially for the band. This has made the Cartoon Jazz Band one of the most original and exciting groups in the San Francisco Bay area.

Currently he is performing with his Cartoon Jazz Band, The Jeff Sanford Quartet, Castles and Concerts with Tom Montgomery, Metrosax, The Martini Brothers, The Golden Gate Park Band, The Frisky Frolics, Celia Ramsey, Dana Land, Patrice Haan, Tony Marcus, Leftover Dreams, Sylvia Herold, Carl Vast, and Joel Abramson Orchestras. Jeff teaches privately and conducts two big band classes weekly in Palo Alto, California.
