

Chouteau County 4H Council
Dog Equipment Agreement

The Chouteau County 4H Council agrees to allow the Great Falls Dog Training Club to lease the dog agility equipment for a period of one year at no charge based upon the following terms:

Diane Darling will be in charge of picking up, transporting to Great Falls and returning the equipment.

The equipment will be stored in Great Falls at the expense of the Dog Club.

Chouteau County will have priority option for use of the equipment. If the equipment is needed by the 4H Council, the Dog Club will ensure that it is returned in time for any dog activity in Chouteau County. The 4H Council will give the Great Falls Dog Club at least 4 weeks notice of any upcoming training needs.

If needed for the Chouteau County Fair, the equipment will be returned to Chouteau County at least 4 weeks prior to the Fair – which will start on August 19, 2010.

The equipment will be returned in the condition in which it was when picked up by the club. In the case of any damages, the equipment will either be repaired or replaced if necessary – with all applicable expenses the obligation of the Great Falls Dog Training Club.
