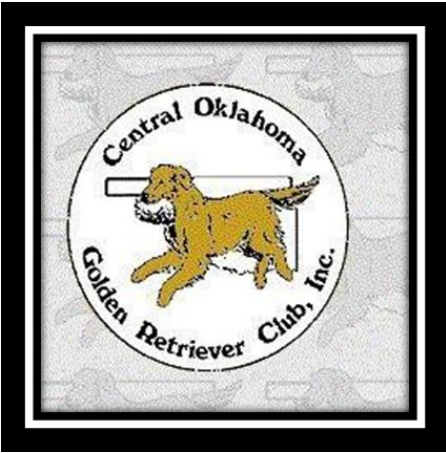

If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC rule, Chapter 11, Section 2)

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Any entries sent by express or overnight courier must contain a signature waiver. The Show Secretary will not be responsible for late entries due to a signature requirement.

Ringside

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class.

Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

GROOMING/CRATING

Two wash bay areas for bathing of dogs are provided in the show building, weather permitting-**COLD WATER ONLY**. No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside the show building. Plentiful electric outlets are available. There is ample exhibitor crating/grooming in designated areas only please. Obedience crating will be provided near the obedience ring. Exhibitors/handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their areas. The show committee reserves the right to control roped off areas.

RV Parking

The Cleveland Co. Fairgrounds (the show site) first come, first served. There are 20 spots for \$25.00 each per night which includes water, electricity & sewer. For more info call 405 360-4721

Supplies will be provided for picking up after dogs that are exercised on the grounds of the show site. Dogs should not be allowed to urinate in planted beds or on sides of buildings. Any damages to hotels or show site may result in disciplinary action by the show committee, including any hotel or show site complaint for the failure to clean up after your dogs and destruction of property. Hotels are considered part of the show site.

Parking is permitted only in designated areas. Extra spaces may not be saved by using ropes or traffic cones.

Handicapped Access: There is handicapped access to all areas with handicapped facilities.

Exhibitors and handler will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates. Please keep dogs on leashes at all times on the show grounds and at hotels. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

The Club, their members Executive boards, Secretary and the Cleveland Co. Fairgrounds as such will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. All persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the Golden Retriever Club of America, the Central Oklahoma Golden Retriever Club or the Cleveland Co. Fairgrounds or its members or employees in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

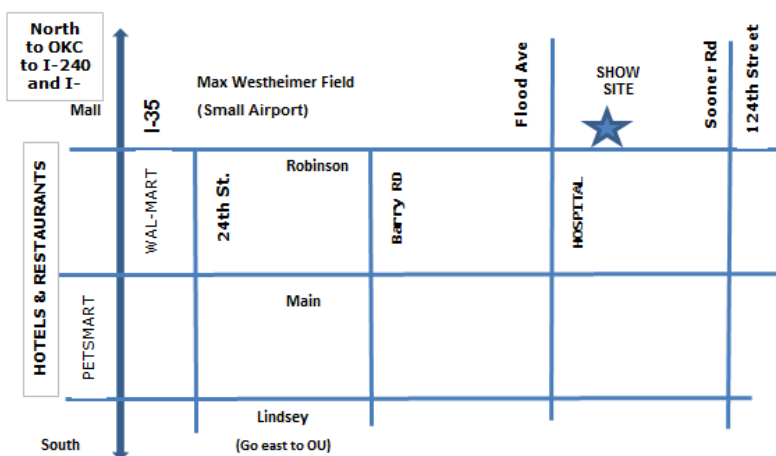
Routes to the Show Site
