*ENTRY AND CONFIRMATION INFORMATION*

\*\*\*Hand deliveries cannot be accepted during the first 24 hours after the match opens.\*\*\*

- Limit: 10 entries per envelope. One entry = one dog. Envelopes containing more than 10 entries will be returned.
- Paper entries received within the first 24 hours of the opening date & time must: 1) include postage or be metered; 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to sender. You must waive signature requirements when using services that utilize signature verifications.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed in full. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry form will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, fees and reverse side of entry form with agreement signed, nor will credit cards or faxed entries be accepted with paper entries.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry; no refund for duplicate entries. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- An email confirmation will be sent at the time of processing if a legible, valid email address is provided on the entry form. Additional confirmations will be emailed to acknowledge move-ups and corrections/changes (prior to closing). A final confirmation and the judging program will be emailed after the match closes. If you cannot receive a Microsoft Word text file, or if you do not check your email, do NOT include your email address. Printed confirmations and Judging Programs are mailed to exhibitors without email addresses after the match closes. **OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING ALL INFORMATION IN THE CONFIRMATION LETTER EACH TIME IT IS SENT AND CONTACTING THE MATCH SECRETARY IMMEDIATELY IN WRITING (EMAIL) IF A CORRECTION/CHANGE NEEDS TO BE MADE.**

**A COPY OF THE DOG'S JUMP HEIGHT CARD IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED WITH YOUR ENTRY.**

AKC Jump Height Cards - NOTE NEW RULES EFFECTIVE 1/1/10

All dogs competing in agility must possess an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs (except those jumping 24" or 26") without jump height cards/forms must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class; this measurement will be valid for the weekend of trials only. If a Volunteer Measuring Official or an Agility Field Rep is present, all dogs without a valid jump height card/form must be measured at some time during the trial. If the dog cannot be measured by the VMO prior to running, it must be measured by the judge before its first run. You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry.

You are required to mark on your entry form your dog's height card status. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to request measurement. If your dog does not have a valid height card for a trial and is not measured by a VMO, if present, any qualifying runs earned will be disallowed. If no VMO is present, your dog must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- Choke collars, pinch collars, prong collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on match grounds.
- Absolutely no exercising the dogs inside the building. Pottying belongs outside. Potty only in designated areas. PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG!
- Running order will be determined by computer-generated random draw. Handlers with multiple dogs in one class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined in crates when not being judged or at the warm up jump.
- Free parking is available for exhibitors. Park at your own risk. **DO NOT PARK on the neighborhood streets surrounding the facility. Park only in the facility parking lot!**
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this match, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- The Club and the Match Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide a public address system or stewards to call or locate dogs that are not present at the ring when required. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run.
- The Club and the Match Facility will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, or for possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this match is in the care and custody of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is in the match building or on the grounds. However, the Match committee reserves the right to enter or authorize entrance to a vehicle using whatever means necessary to rescue dogs in distress. All persons attending this match hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Match committee, be asked to leave the match site. No refund of entry fees will be made.  
  
Dogs may not be left overnight at the match site. Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Matches.
- Glass containers are not allowed in the building.
- No outside food or drink. A concession stand is available.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

## DIRECTIONS TO THE MATCH SITE

From OK-74 N (Lake Hefner Pkwy), take the N. W. 122nd St exit and turn west onto NW 122nd St. Travel 1.2 mi and turn left onto N Meridian Ave and into the Summerfield subdivision. If you reach Broken Tree St you've gone about 0.1 miles too far. Travel 0.2 mi and take the 1st right onto Old Farm Rd. Travel 0.05 mi to 4520 OLD FARM RD on the left.

## WAIT LIST-REFUND POLICY

COGRC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the match's closing date/time. A maximum of twenty-five (25) entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Match Secretary prior to the match closing date as listed on the front of this Premium. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm the Sunday prior to the match will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the match by 6:00 pm the Sunday prior to the first day of the match will receive a full refund.

## MATCH HOURS

The match is being held at the same site as the Red Dirt Agility Club of Oklahoma's trial on May 24. The building will be open during the RDAC trial and set up is permitted at any time the RDAC trial is underway. The match will begin at 4:00 pm or 30 minutes after the RDAC trial concludes for the day, **WHICHEVER IS EARLIER**. We expect to be finished by 9:00 pm

## WALK-THRUS & WARM-UPS

Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. Each walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class/jump height.

## RING DIMENSIONS & SURFACE

The match will be held indoors on artificial soccer turf surface in a climate-controlled (Air Conditioned) arena. This match may use electronic timers. The ring sizes are a minimum of: **Ring 1- 150' X 85'; Ring 2 - 115' X 85'**. Two alternating rings will be used.

## REFUND POLICY

- Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time.
- Refund checks must be cashed within 90 days or check can be canceled.
- No refunds will be made for any entry pulled after the closing date except as stated above referenced as Wait List – Refund Policy.
- The club will provide full refunds less \$10 processing fee for bitches in season, injured or sick dogs. Written Verification from a veterinarian must be submitted to the Match Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of the match. Refunds will be mailed after the match.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, barred from competition by action of the Match committee, is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly or if a match cannot open or be completed.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the match cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

### *MOVE UPS*

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Match Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. (See the move-up deadline date on the cover of this premium). Please email pre-match move-up requests to the Match Secretary on or before the deadline noted on the cover of this Premium. No form is necessary, but please include the following information:

- Your first and last name
- Your dog's call name
- The class and jump height to which you would like your dog moved

### *ARMBAND REQUIREMENT*

All competitors **MUST** wear armbands while running. Competitors will not be admitted to the rings without their armbands visible.

### *CLASSES & TITLES OFFERED*

Classes offered at this match are listed on the front of this premium. Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no cross-over between classes allowed at the same set of trials.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

### *AWARDS*

Ribbons, rosettes or prizes will not be awarded at this Match.

### *ELIGIBILITY*

This match is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

### *NOTICE TO NOVICE EXHIBITORS*

A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

- The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
