

# COGRC General Awards Policy

**I - Non-competitive:** All awards to be given by the Central Oklahoma Golden Retriever Club will be non-competitive. Each individual who qualifies for an award will be given an award of equal value regardless of the number of qualifiers. Every effort shall be made to standardize the award given.

**II - Awards year:** The awards year shall be June 1 to May 31. Accomplishments shall be tabulated annually and an awards ceremony shall be held at the club's July meeting.

**III - Awards recorded:** A list of the award winners shall become a part of the club's permanent records and shall be maintained by the club's recording secretary.

**IV - Owner's Qualifications:** To qualify for an award, the owner or co-owner must be a member in good standing of COGRC and: must have attended not less than two general meetings during the awards year, not to include the December party or July picnic; or must have served the club in a significant way through service as an obedience instructor or on a minimum of two committees during the awards year.

**V - Funding:** Funding for COGRC awards will come from the club's general treasury.

**VI - Proof of qualification:** It shall be the responsibility of the owner to provide proof of qualification for an award.

**VII - Conforming to policies:** Any and all annual awards to be given by COGRC must conform to these policies which may be amended by a vote of the general membership.

**VIII - Policies retroactive:** These policies shall be retroactive as accurately as possible to 1985.
