# A LITTLE BACK STORY



began experimenting with and creating Zolarian words in 1973 shortly after experiencing the ‘Boomerang Incident’ – witnessing a UFO. These bits and pieces that would become the language began making their way into the lyrics of the early ZOLAR X music such as Silver Shapes, Recitation and Spacers.

The Zolarian language is a form of communication that involves words, hand gestures and telepathy. It’s fun and is probably easiest to use in a broken style where Zolarian words are used within the native-spoken language. However, it is possible to communicate in full Zolarian and we will cover some of the basics in this e-book.

We hope *Bop Zolte* gives you the tools to get started with our Zolarian and wow your friends. “I mean, after all, some people think we look kind of crazy but we think all of you are astronomical.”

## SOME BASICS

So how do I talk in Zolarian?

- Zolarian is a fairly simply language once you get the hang of it. One Zolarian word can express a range of feelings or meaning - such as “*ameez*” which means to admire, love or really like something. Example: I love this song! *Vee-ameez delart*. But to love your Grandmother would be: *Vee-artia Volta* and to be romantically involved with someone would be *Ve heartia voo* or shortened to simply *Heartia voo* – I love you.
- There is old-style Zolarian and Speed-of-thought Zolarian. Speed-Zolarian is a shortened version of the more formal. We mostly speak the shortened version although the old-style can be found in some of the vintage lyrics.

- When asking a question add the inflection at the end of the sentence and add the Zolarian pronoun at the beginning like this: Do you want coffee? *Voo zakoo'*
- The letter “i” sounds like a long e in most words.
- Plurals are formed by just adding a “z” to the end of the word.
- In the world of Zolarian, there is no word for “hate”.
- We have added diacritical marks which will act as a map in navigating the pronunciation.
