On 1 May 2020, the Alberta Provincial Government announced that they were opening Alberta Parks to vehicles. This is good news for the RES, it means we can now open the gates to its signed up members.

It will not however be business as usual.

There are still rules in place around COVID 19. So, with that in mind, the gates will be open immediately with the following protocols:

1. The gate will remain locked, it will be the responsibility of the members to open the lock with protective gloves. There will be a spray bottle in place for you to spray down the gates after opening and closing for the purpose of disinfecting. Please do not spray the lock, as it will only cause it to rust.
2. The bathroom will also have a spray bottle for disinfecting after each use.
3. The 15-person maximum will remain in place until we are told otherwise by our Provincial people.
4. The 2-meter rule will remain in place for those that are not from the same family. This should not be a problem.
5. You will be responsible for bringing water for your horse, the big tank will remain empty for now.
6. There will be no overnight camping.
