1. Choose a visually interesting fact and draw a picture.
2. Research a fact that you'd like to know more about.
3. Write a short story based on one of the facts.
4. Create a quiz and test a friend. (See page 120-121 of the book for an example.)
5. Create a comic strip about one of the facts.
6. Make up a true or false quiz. Choose five true facts, and then make up five facts (or change the details of five facts in the book). Mix the questions up and see if a friend can figure out which ones are true and which ones are false.
7. Create a Mad Libs-type fill-in-the-blank (noun, verb, adjective, adverb) paragraph based on a fact, and get a friend to play along.
8. Find facts that could have been included under a different section than they were.
9. Create a three-dimensional creature using clay or other craft material to demonstrate a fact.
10. Research and create your own list of amazing facts about the animal kingdom!
