

## **Class Title:** Creative Portraits

**Class Teacher:** Raina Greifer

**Class Description:** Each week students will create self-portraits using different materials from poetry to collages. Resources, guides, and prompts will be provided through an online platform and students will be gathering weekly to share the work they have created.

**Grade Range:** 3<sup>rd</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> graders

**Supplies Needed:** Pen/paper, glue, paints (any type- watercolor, pastels, acrylic and oils are all fine), tape, some device they can take photos with, access to word or google docs, tripod is ideal but not necessary



### **More Information:**

- Majority of activity will be on students' own time
- The teacher will be posting regular prompts and updates on Google Classroom
- Once a week a virtual gathering of instruction, discussion and sharing
- Suggested 4-week length, with possibility of continuous registration
