

So you love our online events, but you lack the IT skills to connect to your TV. Fear not! I am here to help. Here are some easy ways to interface your home system with the big bad internet. You can do it!

1. Laptop to Stereo – you need a cord with a stereo mini-plug on one end, and 2 RCA plugs on the other. Here is a link to the type of cord you need.

2. Connect the mini plug to the headphone out on your Laptop or phone. (warning, before you buy the cord, make sure your Laptop or phone has a headphone output. Some phones have eliminated them)
3. Laptop to TV – If your laptop has an HDMI output, you can simply connect the output from the laptop to an open input on the TV. Here is a link to an HDMI cord.

Note – doing both of these things gives you excellent sound and picture.

4. Amazon – If you have an Amazon fire device, you can use it to download one of their apps to browse the internet. Find the apps section in the menu, and scroll through the available apps to find an internet browser. There are several to choose from including Firefox, Chrome, etc. Once you have installed the app, you can then use the Amazon service to surf the web. Search Blue Bamboo Art Center and you can watch any of our content on your TV. Be sure to bookmark our location. Once you have done the install, and bookmarked our location, you will be able to return any time without re-installing, or searching.
5. AppleTV – Includes the option of connecting to any of your Apple devices.

3 and 4 are great if you want to avoid cables and connections. If you already have the Amazon or Apple device you can do everything from the couch!
