

What is a house show and why should I host one?

A house show is a unique experience because of its simplicity and intimacy with the artist sharing. No stage, no lights, no separation. Hear stories and songs from a well-respected artist right there in the comfort and familiarity of your own home.

What are the requirements?

There is a base fee of \$600 plus \$100 for travel costs. For lodging, please provide either a hotel room (preferred) or guest home stay with privacy. The fee can be offset by a \$15-20 suggested donation taken up at the end of the evening or at the door, which goes directly to the host. Other than that, you just need a comfortable room that can hold your friends.

How many people do we need?

We recommend aiming for a minimum of 25-30 folks to help offset your costs. This is around the size of a group for critical mass, and for it to feel like a proper, intimate concert. (A few less is by no means a deal-breaker, if your house is on the smaller side.)

How long will the concert be?

60-75 minutes.

An evening generally unfolds like this:

4:00 pm - arrival day of show, visit with hosts
4:30/5:00 pm - setup merch display & performance area
6:30 pm - guests arrive
7:00 pm - concert
8:30 pm - wrap-up, guests check out merch & mingle
