The Dogwood Festival Queen and Court will be crowned at the 2018 Dogwood Festival, April 26-29. The following information outlines the purpose, rules, procedure, responsibilities, and judging criteria of the contest; and instructions for completing the application are on the back. Attached are the actual application and recommendation forms.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Pike County Dogwood Festival Jr. Miss Contest is to select a young woman as Jr. Miss to positively represent Pike County and the Dogwood Festival. She is expected to be role models for the community and spokespersons for the festival.

RULES:

Applicants for Dogwood Festival Jr. Miss must meet the following criteria to participate in the contest and to reign for the year (Dogwood of 2018 to Dogwood of 2019):

- ✓ Be between 11 to 13 years of age as of April 1, 2018
- ✓ Presently be a student in a Pike County school
- ✓ Maintain at least a (C) grade point average
- ✓ Never have been, presently be, or become any of the following: married, pregnant, expelled or suspended from school, arrested, or a user of drugs, alcohol, or cigarettes

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The 2018 Pike County Dogwood Festival Jr. Miss will be spokeswomen for the festival and will be responsible for several duties as outlined below:

Jr. Miss:

- Attendance at the Dogwood Festival (April 26-29, 2018) on Thursday (evening), Friday (evening), Saturday (all day), and Sunday (all day)— a specific schedule of all required events at which you will be assisting or speaking will be provided. Appropriate attire and personal hygiene are required during the festival; no piercings (other than ears) or tattoos showing, no shorts, jeans, too-short/tight skirts, tube tops, spaghetti straps, belly-baring/tight shirts, strapless tops, see-through garments, or any other inappropriate or revealing clothing. Dress slacks, skirts, and/or dresses are recommended.
- Representation of the Dogwood Festival by attending required OFEA events (the 2018 Dogwood Parade is your first) During your reign, which is until the 2018 Dogwood Festival—please realize that any transportation to, from, or during events it is your parents/guardians responsibility. At these events, your duty is to promote the Dogwood Festival by dressing appropriately, wearing your sash and crown, participating in parades and/or luncheons if possible, and publicly speaking about the Dogwood Festival.

PROCEDURE:

The 2018 Dogwood Festival Jr. Miss selection will occur in the following stages:

- 1) Completion and Submission of an Application, Two Recommendations, and Parental Release Form, royalty contract, and \$10.00 entry fee (**by Wednesday February 21, 2018**)—late submissions will NOT be accepted
- 2) Brief Informational Meeting (**Wednesday February 21, 2018; Dogwood Committee Office; 4:30 P.M.**)
- 3) Interview **Process (Sunday, February 25, 2018; Dogwood Committee Office.; Times will be scheduled at the informational meeting)**
- 4) Announcement of Jr. Miss will be posted on the door and facebook (**following all interviews on Sunday, February 25, 2018—late evening**)
- 5) Crowning of Court and Queen (**Thursday, April 26, 2018 during the Dogwood Festival Opening Ceremony**)
