A. Moses Parent's Choice.

²³ By faith Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child, and they were not afraid of the king's edict.

B. Moses' Choices

- **He refused to be defined by others.**

²⁴ By faith, Moses, when he had grown up, REFUSED to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter.

Hebrews 11:24

- **He was willing to give up to go up!**

²⁵ Moses CHOSE to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time.

Hebrews 11:25

Sin will take you farther than you want go.

Sin will leave you longer than you want stay and
sin will cost you far more than you were willing to pay.

- **He obeyed God, not the culture!**

²⁶ He REGARDED disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than all the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward in heaven.

Hebrews 11:26

- **He chose to live by faith rather than by fear.**

²⁷ By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he PERSEVERED because he saw him who is invisible.
