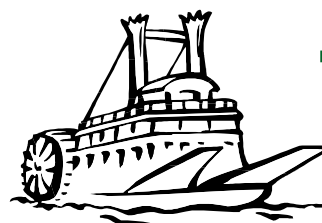

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged therewith.
2. Stall Fees: \$375.00 for all three shows or \$200.00 for box stalls with doors for CCC and \$100.00 per show for HF or MT. Permanent Box Stalls with doors and clay floors. FOR STALL RESERVATIONS: Naomi Blumenthal at (315)436-1933 or nblumenthal@twcny.rr.com. Preferred stall locations will be reserved for those participating in the entire series. **Stalls for single shows may not be available until after 5 PM Prior Day and may not have been cleaned.**
3. No person shall be allowed to ride in an Amateur Class who does not have a current USEF amateur certification or complete the appropriate paper work to apply for one in the show office. No Charge For Amateur Cards for USEF Members. All Pony, Junior and Children's Pony Hunters must show current measurement cards or be measured at the show. No charge for measurement for members.
4. The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show and to combine or cancel classes in accordance with the USEF rules.
5. All prize money will be paid in the show office or deducted from entry bills.
6. There will be a \$100.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. A billing charge of \$35.00 will be added to all accounts not settled in full at the show.
7. All horses not purchasing stalls will be charged a \$50.00 grounds fee per show.
8. The Chemung County Summer Series principals and the show manager take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to horses, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.
9. Each horse/rider per show will be charged a \$35.00 EMT/Insurance fee per show.
10. There will be a \$35.00 fee for every vehicle parked on the grounds in which someone is sleeping each day/night even if the vehicle is not using a hookup. **Campers must park in designated areas.** Campers arriving early are charged even if not occupied.
11. Each horse will be charged per show a \$23.00 USEF Fee (\$8 FOR D&M and \$15 USEF Service Fee) and a \$7.00 USHJA Fee. USEF Non-Members Show Pass \$45 and USHJA Show Pass \$30. **NOT APPLICABLE TO OUTREACH RING**
12. All entry fees will be refunded if entries are cancelled on or before July 9th. There will be a \$25.00 office charge for all scratches after July 9th. There will be no refunds on stalls at any time unless the show is able to resell them. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes in which they are entered forfeit the fees unless a scratch is made in the horse show office prior to the start of the class.
13. All horses must be registered with the USHJA. Proof of recording and/or registration must be presented when numbers are picked up. **NOT APPLICABLE TO OUTREACH RING**
14. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, and Combined Driving Competitions at the advanced level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions, and Combined Driving Competitions, upon payment of a \$45 show pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk/trot; (Exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**

PLEASE NOTE:

The following Health Requirements **MUST** be met by all horses.

A proof of a current Rabies Inoculation administered within 12 months and Proof of Influenza and Herpes vaccines within six months per USEF GR845 s must be presented for each horse.

HORSES STABLED IN NEW YORK STATE:

Must present a **Coggins** Test certificate dated in 2019 or 2020.

HORSES STABLED OUTSIDE NY STATE:

Must present a **Coggins** Test certificate-dated SINCE 7/18 and a current Health Certificate-dated within 30 days of your arrival in NY State.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardians(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of a device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

The Competitions are held on the Chemung County Fairgrounds, Horseheads, NY Exhibitors from the West Continue on Route 17/86 East approximately 8 miles East of Corning. Turn right onto Grand Central Avenue at the light just past the K-Mart Plaza. The Fairgrounds is about 3 blocks on the left.

Exhibitors from the East continue past the Elmira Exit on Rt 17/86, until you come to the 2nd traffic light. Turn left onto Grand Central and the Fairgrounds is about 3 blocks on the left.

Exhibitors from the North Take Rt 13 south to Rt 17/86 West. Follow directions above.

Exhibitors from the South Follow the signs to Rt 17/86 and see directions above.

RULES GOVERNING THE AWARDS

1. To be eligible for High Score Awards, all horses and ponies must be nominated and the person(s) in whose name(s) the horse or pony is showing, or the child who is showing in horsemanship classes, must be a current member of the Syracuse Chapter PHA. No points will count towards the High Score Awards until after the dues and nominations are received by the PHA Secretary.

2. THE SYRACUSE PHA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES

Unless noted otherwise, all classes to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles, which may include one combination including an oxer and one change of direction. Fences for Junior Hunter Riders 3'6" &/or 3'3"; fences for Children's Hunters Horses and Adult Riders 3'; fences for Children's Hunters Large Ponies 2'6", Small-Medium Ponies 2', Pre-Child & Pre-Adult Horses 2'6", Pre-Child Ponies 2'. Medal Class USEF Tests for Jr Hunter Riders 1-17; All others Tests 1-7. Testing is optional in all classes and/or the Judge may elect to include one or more tests in the original course. Every Member show is required to offer a Jr, Children's & Adult PHA Medal Class if they offer the corresponding Hunter Divisions. Other medals are optional. Management may offer a separate class for riders of Children's Hunter Ponies and/or Pre-Children's Ponies. Horses and riders showing in the Junior Hunter Division, may not enter the Children's Medal at the same show. Children's Pony riders may enter the USEF Pony Medal. **Additional rules explained in the current Syracuse PHA Rule Book.**

3. PRE-GREEN HUNTERS - 3' & 3'3" Green Hunters

Open to all horses and ponies in their first or second consecutive year of showing that have never shown in classes where the fences exceed 3'3" at Regular Member USEF or Equine Canada Horse Shows and/or PHA Rated Divisions. Horses may not show in any classes at this show where the fences exceed 3'3".

4. PRE-ADULT & PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTERS

Open to all jr riders on horses or ponies &/or adult riders who have USEF amateur certification. The same horse/ rider combination may not show in any rated division or classes at the same show. Fences 2'6" for horses and 2' for ponies. Any rider showing in any division/class at the same show where the fence height exceeds 3' cannot show in the Pre-Children's/Pre-Adult Hunters (Including the under saddle). Any horse/ rider combination who has previously shown over fences exceeding 3' shall no longer be eligible for the pre-childrens/pre-adult hunter divisions.
