Good luck to the four children going off to Hereford Cathedral School next Wednesday.

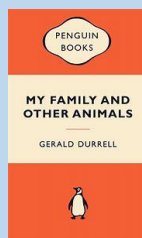


**Year 5** pupils will be heading off to the river next Friday for a fun filled morning. All information has been sent out to parents, please ensure completed forms have been handed back into the school office.
