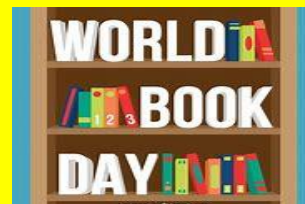


The Eisteddfod competition on Friday 1st March was fantastic once again!
