

Eiks is a Japanese-British singer-songwriter who, as a teenager, first started writing piano music, inspired by Ryuichi Sakamoto and classical music. In her adult years she began writing songs and introduced an open-tuned guitar into the songwriting process (as it was much easier to carry than a piano). Her influences come from Nick Drake and Radiohead and her inspiration comes from her life in London, Jordan, Japan.

Her music is atmospheric with haunting vocals and strong melodies with perceptive lyrics. She describes writing music as an addiction and loves getting lost in the process whilst stumbling across obscure chords.

She records at home, arranges and produces her own music, so maintaining her own 'Eiks' sound. Each of her songs have their own identity, portraying bittersweet melancholy, dreamy atmosphere and intimate reflection.

She first released an EP Morsel of Love in 2013.

Her new album Braids will be released in 2017.
