Clay relocated to the Denver area from Texas in 2016. He competed in the West Texas Talent Search in 2014 and Clay won the King of the Blues 2010 contest in San Antonio, TX for Guitar Center.

His latest CD, "Then and Now", was recorded and released in 2013 at Keith Harter Music. His first solo album was released in 1979, and his second project was recorded in 1983. Clay has worked on countless projects as a studio musician.

Clay has been entertaining for over 30 years. Most recently Clay has performed as a solo artist or with his band and others in the south Texas area. He is excited about the opportunity to collaborate with new musicians in Colorado and hopes to record another CD soon.

"Music should tell a story and get you to the point quick, that's the way I like to write songs," stated Clay, when asked about his new song, "Stay in Your Lane". He is currently working hard on a new music video for that song in addition to 2 more music videos for his all-original compositions.
