What is the Fast CAT?

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line – once readied, the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow it, chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. **The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually.** Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)}$

Based on the dog's size at the withers, a handicap is applied and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points
DCAT = 500 points
FCAT = 1,000 points
FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Top 20 by Breed by Year

The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by Breed by Year national standings. The standings will be updated as event results are processed at https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/fastcat_ranking

Entry Fee:

\$25.00 per entry per dog per test
(Includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

Day of Test entries are **\$30.00** for each entry, and will close 30 minutes prior to roll call at the Field Trial Secretary's table. Day of Test entries accepted as space allows. A stand-by list will be created and these dogs will be allowed to run if time permits. Pre-entries will be acknowledged by email if legible email address is provided in entry form. Entries must be received by May 31st, 2019.

Conditions of Entry:

Dogs must have an AKC registration number, or a Canine Partner number, and be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Dogs may only run once per test. All entries must be accompanied with a check to be valid. Entries received by phone, text, or email will not be accepted. Incomplete entries or forms without signature will not be accepted.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.

Hours: Grounds will be available at 7:00 AM. Roll call and exhibitor briefing begin no later than 7:30AM. GVFRRC will do its best to accommodate exhibitors with conflicts in other venues, if any. However, exhibitors must notify the Field Trial Secretary of possible conflicts and must work their dog into the running order during the regular test schedule. It is also the responsibility of each entrant to make an effort to be ready when their dog is called to the line.

Roll Call: At roll call, all dogs will be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps. Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.

Roll call will begin at 7:30 AM and will be announced by the field committee. Roll call will be continuous, until all runs are complete for that day. EXHIBITOR NOTE – A dog entered in multiple runs, will need to submit for examination / roll call PRIOR to being permitted to make their second run. This will be closely managed by the exam committee members, and the field committee.

Trial Hours: The trials will be run CONCURRENTLY each day, and will start at 8:00 AM until all runs are completed for the day.

Concurrent trials allow us to, ideally, schedule your 2 runs, in a shorter amount of time! Two runs with a fresh dog, instead of a tired, sleepy, and stiff dog – that's spent hours in a crate waiting for a PM trial to start. Additionally – it allows us to accommodate more exhibitors at our trial. Run order will be determined and emailed once the event entry closes. So please be sure to include a valid email address on your entry form.



Prizes

GVFRRRC will offer a light blue flat ribbon for a passing qualifying run.

GVFRRRC will offer Rosettes at each trial (All Breeds Eligible):

- Fastest run in under 12" class
- Fastest run in 12" to 18" class
- Fastest run in 18" or greater class.

GVFRRRC will offer Rosettes for Rhodesian Ridgebacks as follows:

- Saturday Trial 1: Fastest Ridgeback with first Qualifying Run
- Saturday Trial 2: Fastest Male Ridgeback
- Sunday Trial 1: Fastest Ridgeback with first Qualifying Run
- Sunday Trial 2: Fastest Female Ridgeback
- All Weekend: Ridgeback Rabbit – must complete four qualifying runs

There will also be a special ALL BREED Rosette for the single fastest dog for the ENTIRE WEEKEND

(Eligible dogs must compete in all four events to qualify for this special prize - the winner will be based upon FASTEST AVERAGE MPH time).

GVFRRRC will have a limited number of new title rosettes available. Please notify the trial secretary, via email or include with your entry form, if you expect to be earning a new title to ensure that the club will have rosettes available. Rosettes will be title specific.

GVFRRRC will hold a **BREED PRIDE** event on Sunday, June 16th, 2019. Trial participants wearing a breed-specific article of clothing will earn a ticket at roll call for a grand prize drawing! Limit one ticket per person.

Drawing will be held at 12:00 PM on Sunday!

Winner must be present at time of drawing.

From Route 287

Route 287 to Exit 10 toward New Brunswick. Take Easton Avenue to the first light. Make a right onto Cedar Grove Lane. Follow for two miles, and make a right at the fourth light onto Weston Road. Follow to first light and make a left onto Elizabeth Avenue. Colonial Park is on the right. Take a right onto Colonial Drive. Parking Lot C will be the second lot on your right, about 9/10 of a mile in.

From Route 206

Southbound: Take Route 206 to Dukes Parkway. Go through the U-turn and cross back over Route 206. Follow Dukes Parkway to the end, and turn right onto Main Street. Go through the center of Manville. Make a left at the light onto the Manville Causeway (Wilhousky Street). Go over a small bridge and turn right onto Weston Road. Follow Weston Road for 1.5 miles and make the first right onto Mettlers Road. Make a Left onto Colonial Park Drive. Parking Lot C will be the first Park Parking lot on your left.

Northbound: Take 206 to Amwell Road. Make a right at the light onto Amwell Road. After three and a half miles you will see a sign for Colonial Park on the right side. Continue to Elizabeth Ave and turn left. Continue on Elizabeth Ave to the Colonial Park entrance on left - make a left onto Colonial Drive. Parking lot C will be 9/10ths of a mile in, on the right.

From New Brunswick area (Hamilton Street - Amwell Road)

Follow Hamilton Street from New Brunswick - the name changes to Amwell Road in Somerset. Amwell Road comes to a fork; turn left. You are still on Amwell Road. Follow to the second light and make a right onto Elizabeth Avenue. Follow Elizabeth to the Colonial Park entrance on the left. Take this left onto Colonial Drive. Parking lot C will be 9/10ths of a mile in, on the right.

NOTE – The bridge on Mettlers Ave MAY be closed due to construction – So, ALL PARTICIPANTS coming in on Amwell Road are advised to enter the park from Elizabeth Ave / Colonial Drive as noted above!

Food/Water/Shade:

Please be sure to bring enough Food and Shade for the day – it will be June in New Jersey, and there is only so much natural shade at the trial grounds. The parking lot is NOT shaded. Notice To All Exhibitors:

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel, RV and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels, RV sites or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same. All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds and RV sites are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room/site and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its' Event Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel or RV facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.



GVFRRRC Trial Information and Rules:

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- **ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK**
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain or shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- An electronic timing system will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced.
- The FAST CAT course will be fenced.
- On site bathrooms are available and will be located a short walk from the site – at LOC 2 on the park map.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- **A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.**
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. **Entry fees will be refunded.**
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/GVFRRRC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded.**
- **No entry fees will be refunded** if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club. Greater Valley Forge Rhodesian Ridgeback Club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
