*Traveller tip: Very important *** When staying in Kuta, spend extra, get accommodation that has good security, air-conditioning and if possible a well-known brand or recommended by your friends. The difference between spending an extra \$25-\$50 per night can really improve the quality of your accommodation, security, facilities and even include a full breakfast and late checkout.*

Travel Tips:

- Take a mix of cash (USD, AUD and Indonesian Rupiah) in small denominations and card with you.
- Don't forget to visit the Monkey Forest, it's where you can get to meet some of the friendly monkeys and take bananas too!
- Hold your bag close as these little monkeys can be a bit cheeky. Book a driver for the day ~\$50 USD and ask to visit some of the sites out of town, the restaurants overlooking paddy fields.
- It's also an incredible place for photography, start early and beat the traffic!
