Directions

Please provide detailed directions (Swedish or English language) two weeks before the date of the show including

- The complete address of the venue
- A telephone contact
- Arrival, soundcheck, doors-open and on-stage times

Arrival

The promoter or another person should be at the venue at arrival time. We would also greatly appreciate if there is someone on site to help us with setup and carrying stuff before and after the show.

Parking

We will expect free parking for one van (standard parking space size) in close proximity to venue. It must be available for the duration of the evening from load-in to load-out.

Merchandise

We would appreciate a table of approx. 1.5m length and a small light or some candles for our merchandising - in the same room as the show, if possible.

Meals

Unless otherwise agreed beforehand, we will expect a well balanced meal (with beverage) for two, to be scheduled in advance with the band.

We have no special dietary restrictions (vegetarian etc).

Dressing Room and Backstage Requirements

- A dressing room with access to a bathroom
- At least one mirror
- Waste bin and recycling bin for cans/bottles
- Water and glasses/cups or water bottles
- If possible: salty snacks (potato chips, nuts or similar) and cold drinks (soda and/or beer)
