Locomotive Ghost plays their own stories, sharing desperate moments, celebrating mended hearts, and owning up to mistakes. The group's earnest performance and shared male/female vocals have been likened to The Head and the Heart, while their pop sensibilities have yielded comparisons to acts like Of Monsters and Men, and The Lumineers.

Locomotive Ghost's newest album, "Into the Glow", was recorded with award-winning producers Russell Broom and Spencer Cheyne and was largely financed by a successful crowdfunding campaign. "Into the Glow" appeared 23 times on Earshot radio charts across Canada. The track "Shake Awake" won first place in the professional category of the Ship & Anchor Song Contest. The band's recent work was recognized with four nominations at the 2017 YYC Music Awards.

Locomotive Ghost has released three standalone albums, four EPs, one compilation album, and one single. The group has performed at over two hundred events throughout Western Canada.
