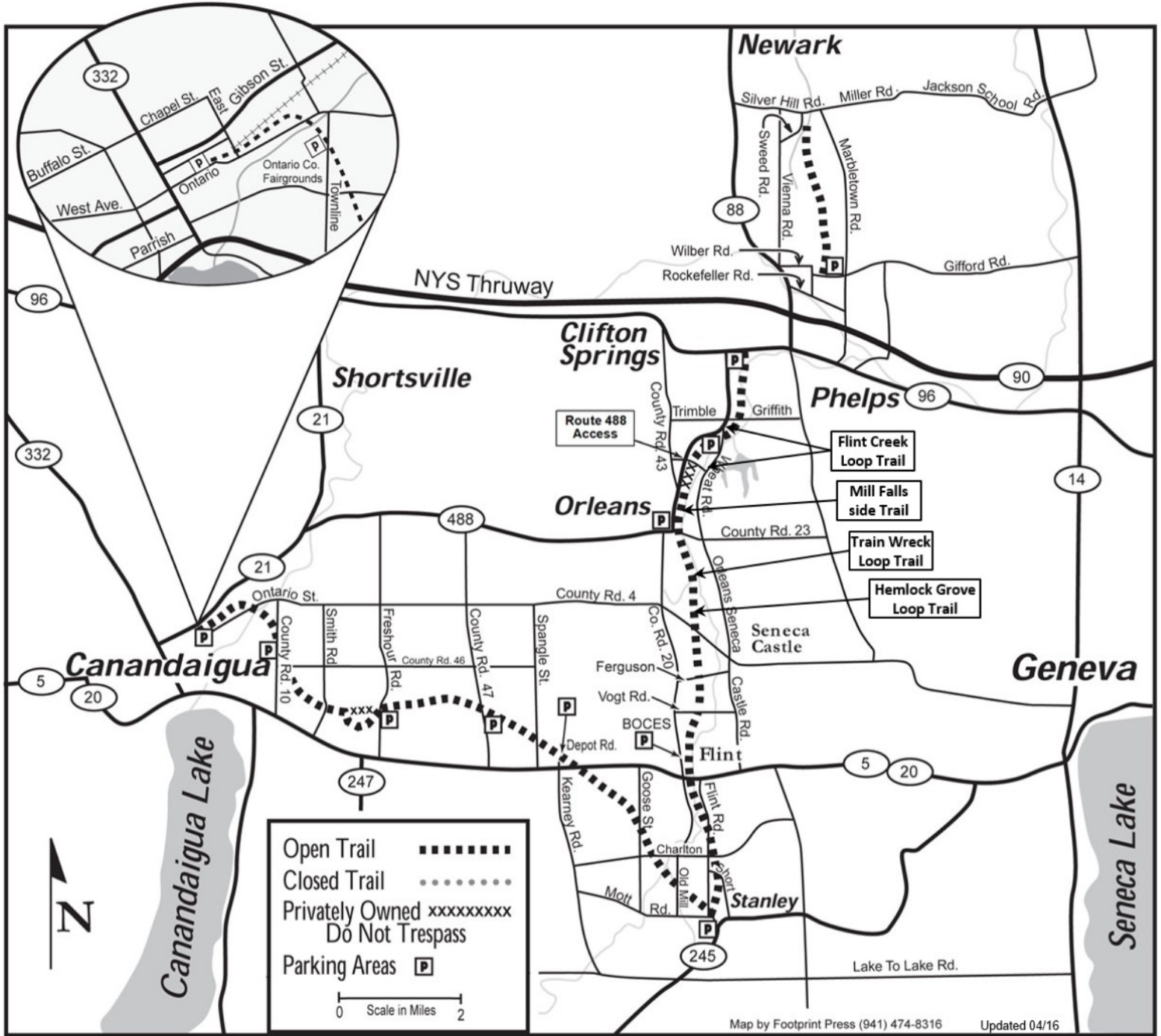


Ontario Pathways Rail Trail

Three Loop Trails:

Flint Creek Loop Trail (≈ 1 mi)

- Blazed with classic white rectangles
- Maintained to a three foot width
- Seasonal hiking trail only, no mountain bikes
- Subject to flooding during spring thaw & heavy rains
- Five access points:
 1. 250 feet south of the Wheat Road trailhead
 2. Access lane near mile point 19.5 / 2.0
 3. At the abandoned roadway further south
 4. Where the 488 bypass joins the trail
 5. Just south of mile point 19 / 2.5

Train Wreck Loop Trail (≈ 0.4 mi)

- Blazed with classic white rectangles
- Maintained to a three foot width
- Hiking trail only, no mountain bikes
- Access at the memorial plaque boulder about 0.5 mi south from the Orleans trailhead (water tower)

Hemlock Grove Loop Trail (≈ 0.3 mi)

- Blazed with classic white rectangles
- Maintained to a three foot width
- Hiking trail only, no mountain bikes
- Access at passport post #4 at the big culvert
