

## New AMENDMENTS for 2018 printed in the new SRA Bylaws & Rules

**Change to STOCK CONTRACTOR:** Stock Contractor must have properly equipped Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel on the rodeo grounds during all rodeo performances and slack with an emergence response vehicle on stand-by.

**Add to RODEOS:** Any co-sanctioned rodeo must be approved by the board of directors.

**Delete from RODEOS:** Stock contractors having three (3) SRA first-sanctioned rodeos may designate one of those rodeos as an Incentive Rodeo. Stock contractors may earn one additional Incentive Rodeo for every three (3) additional SRA-first sanctioned rodeos approved. Contestants will receive two (2) points for every dollar of prize money won.

**Change to SANCTION FEE:** Sanction fee to be ten percent (10%) of gross prize money (added money and entry fees totaled).

**Change to RODEO ENTRY FEES:** Entry fees will be based on added money as follows:

\$200-\$499 Added Money = \$50 Entry Fee  
\$500-\$699 Added Money = \$60 Entry Fee  
\$700-\$799 Added Money = \$70 Entry Fee  
\$800-\$999 Added Money = \$80 Entry Fee  
\$1000-\$1500 Added Money = \$90 Entry Fee  
\$1501 or more Added Money = \$100 Entry Fee

**Change to PAYOFF:** In the Bull Riding, Calf Roping, Steer Wrestling, Team Roping, Barrel Racing, Breakaway events where it reads “until first place exceeds \$600” change to “until first place exceeds \$700”.

**Add to POINT AWARDS:** In case of a tie in the all around cowboy and/or cowgirl championships, the title will be given to the contestant that places highest in the average of their event(s) competed in at the SFR. If contestants are still tied, the title will be given to the contestant that has the most and highest placings in the total number of rounds at the SFR.

The following represent tie breaker examples:

### Scenario 1

Contestant “A” placed 2nd in the Calf Roping average.

Contestant “B” placed 3rd in the Steer Wrestling average.

The contestant placing highest in the average of an event wins, so the All Around Championship would go to Contestant “A”.

### Scenario 2

Contestant “A” placed 2nd in the Calf Roping average.

Contestant “B” placed 2nd in the Steer Wrestling average.

Contestants are still tied, so the next method is needed.

Contestant “A” placed 2nd in round one, 3rd in round two and 3rd in round three.

Contestant “B” placed 1st in round one, 2nd in round two and 3rd in round three.

The contestant with the most and highest placings in the total number of rounds wins, so the All Around Championship would go to Contestant “B” using the method of most & highest placings in rounds.

**Add to SRA FINALS RODEO:** SRA members ranked in 1st-20th place in the SRA Point Standings that are entering to compete at the SFR are required to vote for SFR personnel. Failure to vote will result in a \$50 fine.

**Add to SRA FINALS RODEO:** Stock Contractors are allowed to vote for Pickup Men only.

**Add to SRA FINALS RODEO:** Only "Certified" judges will be listed on the personnel ballot for the SFR.

**Change to SRA FINALS RODEO:** Once a contestant's entry is accepted, there will be no drawing out unless a medical release is received seventy-two (72) hours prior to the first performance, or contestant will be fined one hundred dollars (\$100.00) plus entry fees. Entry Fees will be forfeited if an alternate is not available.

**Add to SRA FINALS RODEO:** Bids must be submitted to the SRA office no later than July 31st each year in order to be considered for SFR positions as announcer, clown/barrel man or performing acts.
