

## AMENDMENTS to the 2007 printed edition of the SRA Bylaws & Rules

**NOTE: In case of conflict in rules, the most recent amendment will be adhered to.**

**Change** to Membership Page 18 #1: "Membership will be valid from October 1st through September 30th of the following year,..." (11/2011)

**Change** to Membership Page 18 #2: "Dues are payable during the month of October." (11/2011)

**Add** to Membership Page 18 section for Non-contestant Labor Members : Annual non-contestant labor memberships are fifty dollars (\$50.00) Non-contestant labor memberships are available to rodeo secretaries, judges and contract acts (announcers, pickup men, bull fighters, barrel men, funnymen and specialty acts). Such membership is a non-competing membership. (10/2012)

**Delete** Permits Page 20 #3 "Permits may not be purchased by any person who held an SRA membership card the prior year." (10/2012)

**Delete** Grand Entry Page 26 #1 "The SRA urges that all colors and grand entries be handled by competent horsemen and horses and that members ride in the grand entry if needed or requested to do so." (10/2014)

**Delete** Grand Entry Page 26 #2 "Any contestant having a horse on the grounds who does not ride in the grand entry when asked to do so by the stock contractor or committee will be fined \$25. Judges will be responsible for enforcing this rule. Rider may be excused by judge, with good reason. (10/2014)

**Change** to Point Awards Page 26 #1, Rodeo Secretary Page 51 #14 & Page 52 #14A, Payoff Page 52 #2: Change sanction fee to 8%. (11/2008)

**Delete** Point Awards Page 27 #8 "Points for All Around Cowboy and Cowgirl will count only for rodeos that offer all eight (8) mandatory events." (10/2013)

**Change** to Point Awards Page 27 #10: "The points are to be counted from October 1st to September 30th of each year..." (11/2011)

**Add** Point Awards Page 27 #10 "In the team roping event , a champion header and champion heeler will be awarded." (10/2013)

**Delete** Points Awards Page 28 #14 "Anyone receiving an SRA year end or SFR championship award that does not attend the awards banquet may be fined \$50 which must be paid before recipient will be given the award." (10/2014)

**Delete** Points Awards Page 28 #15 "Memorial awards may be presented by the donor of the award at the SRA banquet; however," (10/2014)

**Change** to SRA Finals Rodeo Page 28 #3 "Contestants must compete in the event at a minimum of one (1) SRA first-sanctioned rodeos to be eligible to compete at the finals." (10/2013)

**Add** to SRA FINALS RODEO Page 28 #3: "If the stock contractor cancels an event due to lack of entries or inclement weather, the rodeo will count toward satisfying the minimum SRA first-sanctioned rodeos to qualify for finals for contestants entered during call-in." (11/2009)

**Change** SRA Finals Rodeo Page 29 #7 "Team ropers may only enter one time in the team roping event at the finals. The top 12 header qualifiers must team up with the top 12 heeling qualifiers." (10/2013)

**Change** to SFR Stock Page 32 #2: "Stock contractors having a minimum of one (1) SRA first-sanctioned rodeo will be eligible for year end awards." (11/2010)

**Change** to SFR Stock Page 33 #3: "Stock contractors with a minimum of one (1) SRA first-sanctioned rodeo will be eligible for SFR awards." (11/2010)

**Change** to SFR Stock Page 33 #4: "Stock contractors with a minimum of one (1) SRA first-sanctioned rodeo will be eligible to furnish rough stock that have a minimum of two (2) outs during the current rodeo season for the SFR." (11/2010)

**Delete** SFR Stock Page 33 #5 (11/2010)

**Delete** Contract Acts Page 34 #2 "If a contract act is not a SRA member, a one rodeo permit must be purchased. If they work a second rodeo in the same fiscal year, they will be required to purchase a card." (10/2012)

**Delete** Contract Acts Page 34 Rule #2 "If a contract act is not a SRA member, a one rodeo permit must be purchased. If they work a second rodeo in the same fiscal year, they will be required to purchase a card." (10/2012)

**Delete** Postponement Page 37 #5 "Points will not be counted for rodeos in which any portion of the rodeo was cancelled." (10/2012)

**Add** Postponement Page 37 #5 "If a contestant is entered in a rodeo and any portion of the rodeo is cancelled, the rodeo will count toward satisfying the minimum SRA first-sanctioned rodeos to qualify for finals. If notification of turnout is given or medical/vet release is submitted prior to cancellation of rodeo, the rodeo will not count for that individual." (10/2013)

**Delete** Rodeos Page 38 #4 "for any event" (10/2014)

**Add** Rodeos Page 38 #4 "Added money at specialty events will be no less than \$500. (10/2014)

**Add** Rodeos Page 39 #5 "Stock contractors having three (3) SRA first-sanctioned rodeos may designate one of those rodeos as an Incentive Rodeo. Stock contractors may earn one additional Incentive Rodeo for every three (3) additional SRA-first sanctioned rodeos approved. Contestants will receive two (2) points for every dollar of prize money won. (10/2014)

**Add** Rodeos Page 39 #5 "Stock contractors will be allowed to sanction one specialty event (i.e. Bulls and Barrels) with a minimum of \$500 added money per event for every three (3) SRA-first sanctioned rodeos approved. (10/2014)

**Change** to Rodeos Page 40 #18 "Stock contractors have the option to charge a stock contractor fee per entry (per team in team roping) based on the amount of added money. For rodeos adding a minimum of \$500, a \$10 per entry stock contractor fee may be charged. Any rodeo adding less than \$500, may charge a \$5 stock contractor fee per entry. The stock contractor fee applies in the barrel racing, so stock contractors cannot charge an additional electric timer fee. (10/2012)

**Change** to Rodeo Entry Guidelines Page 42 #14 "Seven breakaway roping contestants must be accepted before calling a performance full." (10/2012)

**Change** to Rodeo Entry Guidelines Page 42 #17 "If four (4) or more total entries are received in any advertised event, the event cannot be cancelled." (10/2012)

**Add** to Rodeo Entry Guidelines Page 43 #20 "Stock contractors have the option to request that the current Top 12 contestants in each event be moved to the performance for rodeos with \$750 or more in added money." (10/2014)

**Add** to Rodeo Entry Guidelines Page 43 #25: "All Contestants are allowed to trade position for position. Must have confirmation numbers of all contestants involved. If a confirmation number cannot be produced then card numbers and the last 4 digits of SSN for all contestants involved will be accepted. Deadline for trading is 4pm CST the next business day after books close for the rodeo." (09/2016)

**Change** to Rodeo Entry Fees Page 44 #1 Entry Fee Scale for rodeos with \$200-\$499 added money, the entry fee will be \$40 (10/2012)

**Change** to Rodeo Officials Page 47 #4 "No less than the following may be paid to rodeo officials per performance: Secretary -\$200, Judges - \$200, Timers - \$100" (10/2012)

**Change** Rodeo Secretary Page 51 #14 "The following (books) must be mailed (postmarked) to the SRA office not later than 3 business days after completion of the rodeo" to "The following must be received by the SRA office not later than 3 business days after completion of the rodeo" (10/2014)

**Add** Rodeo Secretary Page 51 #14 "Turnout reports should be electronically submitted to the SRA office within 24 hours after the last performance of a rodeo." (10/2014)

**Change** to Payoff Page 53 #3 each time where it reads "until first place exceeds \$500" change to "until first place exceeds \$600" in the Bull Riding, Calf Roping, Steer Wrestling, Team Roping, Barrel Racing, Breakaway events (10/2012)

**Change** to Payoff Page 53 #3 Bareback event payoff to the same as Saddle Bronc event payoff (10/2012)

**Change** to Rodeo Judges Page 63 #1 "All judges must be approved by the SRA Board of Directors, hold a current SRA card and be a member in good standing to judge a rodeo. Judges will be required to attend a judging clinic at least once every three years. Judges will be classified by the Board of Directors as "Certified" or "Qualified". There must be at least one Certified Judge at each rodeo." (10/2012)

**Change** to Rodeo Judges Page 63 #2 "Any person seeking to be approved as a judge must submit a request to the SRA Board of Directors after attending an SRA judging clinic." (10/2012)

**Add** to Rodeo Judges Page 63 #3 "The SRA office will maintain a list of certified and qualified judges." (10/2012)

**Delete** Judging Methods/Timed Events Page 69 #1 "All steers must be branded or ear tattooed with year number." (10/2014)

**Add** Barriers Page 70 #1 "Score line is defined as the point that the barrier is released from the pin when pulled out from the box parallel to the ground." (10/2014)

**Add** Barriers Page 72 #9 "If a contestant's horse jumps the barrier during a run before the barrier pulls and the barrier does not break, the contestant will received a 10 second penalty for beating the barrier." (10/2014)

**Change** Saddle Bronc Riding Page 77 #2 "but must be sanctioned by the judges" to "Stock contractor may request inspection by judges to ensure contestant has proper equipment." (10/2014)

**Delete** Saddle Bronc Riding Page 77 #10 "Judges will inspect every saddle before each performance or be fined \$50 for each offense." (10/2014)

**Change** to General Timed Event Rules Page 84 #11 & Cowgirls Barrel Racing Page 80 #2: "sixty (60) second time limit" to "thirty (30) second time limit". (09/2016)

**Add** General Timed Events Page 87 #29 "A rerun will not be given if rope is thrown in roping events or steer is jumped in steer wrestling." (10/2014)

**Change** to Calf Roping Page 88 #8 (Begin with) "Should the roper or his horse take the slack out of the rope during the 5 second time period," change to "Should the horse take the slack out of the rope during the 5 second time period, the judge will stop time until slack is put back in the rope and then resume time until 5 second time period is reached. If the contestant intentionally takes the slack out of the rope, contestant will be disqualified and fined." (10/2012)

**Delete** Calf Roping Page 88 #8 “However, judge may waive 5 second period to give calf air and roper will receive time.” (10/2014)

**Add** Calf Roping Page 89 #10F “Jerkdown rule will not be in effect unless calves have been run a minimum of 3 times.” (10/2014)

**Add** to Cowgirls Breakaway Roping Page 94 #11 “No extremities can be in the loop at the time the rope comes tight and breaks from the saddle horn.” (10/2012)
