

## □ **There is another instruction!**

- **Genesis 22:9-12 KJV** - [9] *And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood. 10] And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son. 11] And the angel of the Lord called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I. 12] And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from me.*

Knowledge from the Hebrew term Yada meaning to be aware, to comprehend, to discern, to discover to be learned, to perceive, to prognosticate. Purpose is time sensitive, we cannot afford to NOT BE SURE concerning God's will for our lives and make some ill-advised move or decision that is going to us years back in a season where "every moment matters".

**Isaiah 40:31** But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength:

A: They shall (mount up with wings as eagles = The foresight which comes from thinking on a higher level. The bible calls that Vision.

B: They shall run and not be weary; =strength to endure to the end

C: And they shall walk, and not faint = Definition, direction and the fulfillment of purpose through patience

- PP: The key is what you DISCOVER AFTER you recover.

**I Corinthians 14:33** "For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace....

**Ephesians 5:17.** Wherefore be ye not unwise, but UNDERSTANDING what the will of the Lord is.

Let us not confuse the mystery of the Godhead with mysticism.

1: Mysticism is defined as a vague speculation: a belief without sound basis.

2: Mysticism is a theory postulating the possibility of direct and intuitive acquisition of ineffable knowledge or power.

There is no way I would risk my only and eternal soul on a vague speculation or some theory constructed by a human being without sound biblical principal based on the written and revealed word of God.

**II Tim 1:12** *"I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day".*

- **PP:** God doesn't need my plan B!
- **PP:** Wisdom is the appropriate application to real life situations of principles and precepts acquired through the pursuit of knowledge.

Having access to knowledge is of no benefit to the fulfillment of your destiny if you don't actually transition from:

- A: Revelation (which is spiritual) to
- B: Comprehension (which is intellectual) to...
- C: Application which practical

**II Chron 1: 10.** - "Give me now wisdom and knowledge, that I may go out and come in before this people: for who can judge this thy people, that is so great?"

- **PowerPoint:** One of the keys to greatness is understanding that YOU as an individual are never greater than the sum total of the people you serve;

**II Chron 1: 11 - 11.** *And God said to Solomon, because this was in thine heart, and thou hast not asked riches, wealth, or honor, nor the life of thine enemies, neither ye hast asked long life; but hast asked wisdom and knowledge for thyself, that thou mayest judge MY PEOPLE, over whom I have made thee king: 12. Wisdom and knowledge is granted unto thee; and I will give thee riches, and wealth, and honor, such as none of the kings have had that have been before thee, neither shall there any after thee have the like.*

- If you will pray for wisdom and the understanding of God's will through the recognition of his voice, you will be uniquely blessed among your generation.

Question:

What do you do when God speaks, but what he tells you is what you don't want to hear?

**Gen 22:1** *And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham; and he said, Behold, here I am.2] And he said, take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer*

*him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of. 3] And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Issac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.*

- **PowerPoint:** You won't always know WHY you are going WHERE you are going or WHAT God will do WHEN you get there, but PURPOSE cannot happen outside of THE PLACE God has designated to reveal his will.

**Genesis 22:4** - *4] Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off. 5] And Abraham said unto his young men, abide ye here with the ass; and I and the lad will go yonder and worship, and come again to you. 6] And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and laid it upon Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife; and they went both of them together*

- PP: typeology - A replica of the real thing under discussion or a foreshadowing of a thing that is to be presented later.

In this text:

1. Abraham is a type of God:
2. Issac is a type of Christ.
3. The two young men that Abraham brings with him are a foreshadowing of the 2 thieves that would be crucified with Jesus.

**Gen 22:7-10** - *And Issac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father; and he said, Here am I, my son. And he said, behold the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering? 8. And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering; so they went both of them together. 9. And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood. 10. And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.....*

- PP: God will always respond favorably to true worship.
- PP: Obedience IS worship!

**Gen 22:11-12** - *And the angel of the Lord called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham, and he said, Here am I. 12. And he said, lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou anything unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thine only son from me.*

Keep Listening. stretch forth your hand!! There is another instruction!!

**Genesis 22:13-18 KJV** - *[13] And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son. 14] And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovah-jireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the Lord it shall be seen. 15] And the angel of the Lord called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time, 16] And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the Lord, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son :[17] That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies; 18] And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.*
