

LABRADOR RETRIEVER CLUB OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Perpetual Trophies

To run in conjunction with the Financial Year commencing the 1st of October and ending the 30th of September. For all trophies listed below the following rules will apply. Only registered Labrador Retrievers are eligible for trophies unless otherwise stated. Trophies are available to financial members only. For fees received after the 31st of December, points will be taken from date of receipt of fees. All Labrador Dogs and Bitches must have SA as its principle place of residence. Trophies to be returned to club 30 days prior to AGM.

President's Trophy Donated by Mr J Styles

For the Labrador Retriever with the highest number of challenge points won in one (1) year. Points won interstate to be included. **Neutered Challenge points are ineligible to be counted.**

Fleetwood Trophy Donated by Mrs J & Mr C Fleetwood

For the opposite sex Labrador Retriever with the highest number of challenge points won in one (1) year. Points won interstate to be included. **Neutered Challenge points are ineligible to be counted.**

Kadlinga Trophy Donated by Mr & Mrs G Jenner

For the Labrador Retriever winning the most Retrieving Trial Championship points in one (1) year. Points won interstate to be included. In case of a tie or no championship points earned the trophy will be awarded on a point system as for the Temora Trophy.

Kinsydal Dual Purpose Trophy Donated by Kinsydal Kennels

For the Labrador Retriever who is awarded the most points in Retrieving/Field and Conformation Shows in one (1) year. This trophy will be awarded to a dog or bitch that has attained a minimum of 6 challenge points at Championship Shows and an equal number of points at Retrieving and or Field Trials.

Neutered Challenge points are ineligible to be counted.

Make Me Magic "Casey" Trophy

For the Yellow Labrador Retriever with the highest number of challenge points won in one (1) year. Points won interstate to be included. **Neutered Challenge points are ineligible to be counted.**

For the Neuter Labrador Retriever who is awarded the most points in Conformation Shows and any other Discipline in one (1) year. This trophy will be awarded to a dog or b who has attained a minimum of 25 Neuter challenge points at Championship Shows and points in any or all of the following Disciplines.
