## Short Bio

Influenced by an eclectic mix, from The Beatles and Karen Carpenter, to Lauren Hill and John Mayer, singer songwriter Abbie Thomas mixes catchy melodies with hard-hitting, truthful lyrics. After encouragement from industry bookers, she played her first open mic in 2018 and immediately silenced the room with her original song, "Try". She has quickly moved from open-mic regular, to booking her own shows featuring her original music, and was also a songwriting finalist at The Acorn Theater in June 2019. A champion for up-and-coming musicians, venue host Hannah Hoefler raves, "*Abbie is a talented musician who is entertaining and connects with you at an authentic and emotional level. A Hoefler House favorite!*" Abbie is also gaining a reputation for putting on fun, interactive live shows by putting her own twist on crowd favorites like "Ain't No Sunshine" by Bill Withers and "Seven Nation Army" from The White Stripes.
