Brookshire LLP will be treating the Sunset Maple street trees for Spotted Lantern Flies on Thursday, May 21 and 28, and June 4, 2020. We will be applying a systemic treatment approximately 12 inches around the base of the trunk. Please keep pets off the treated area at least two hours or until dry.

Ruth's vocation is musician ministry, and music teacher. Wayne is a minister, Bible teacher, worship leader, musician, and Spanish teacher.

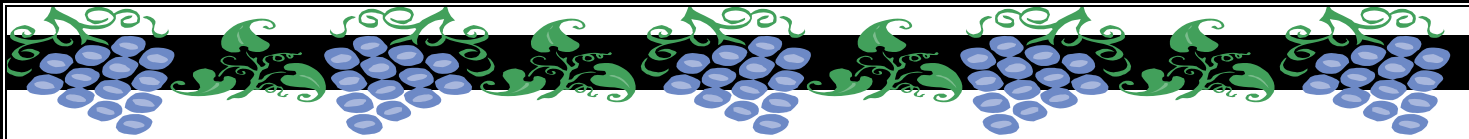
