

Dunscar Conservative Club - Covid -19 Safety Rules

We can only operate safely with the goodwill of all members; please follow these rules and help us to ensure your safety and that of other members. Just as the government is relying upon the good common sense of the population in relaxing the lockdown, we too are equally reliant on you as responsible members of Dunscar Conservative Club. We have a legal obligation to implement the guidelines. Please note that a failure to follow these rules may result in you being asked to leave the club.

- Please do not come to the club if you are unwell and have Cod-19 symptoms - <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/>
- On entry to the club at the foyer, please proceed to the member area entry door on the left hand side of the foyer – see layout plan
- Please maintain 2 metre distancing at all times
- Use the hand sanitiser provided at various locations in the club
- Do not come to the bar and stand against it
- Please find a vacant seat after entering the club, complete the registration form and place your order by text to 07726577246 quoting your table number
- Do not rearrange chairs or tables as these have been configured to ensure social distancing
- If at all possible pay for drinks by contactless card transaction
- Do not return empty glasses to the bar –they will be collected
- Please wait in a suitable free space in the foyer to use the toilet if it is locked and already in use
- If you have children with you, please ensure active supervision of them – they should remain with you at all times
- We regret that dogs are not allowed in the club for the moment – we will notify you when this rule is to be relaxed
- Indoor games are not permitted at this time – snooker, pool, darts, dominoes and cards. Televised football is not allowed. We will reinstate games and televised football as soon as guidance permits
- When using the gaming machines, please use the hand sanitiser after use and clean any surfaces you have touched – a notice will explain the required actions
- A member may only bring one signed in visitor at this time
- A member may still bring in a partner and children of the household at this time
- You can meet indoors in groups of up to two households (your support bubble counts as one household), subject to social distancing.
- If using the outside area of the club please maintain social distancing and use the seating provided. Outdoor areas should not be used after 9pm
- If you are intent on meeting friends and family outside at the club please follow the rules on maximum numbers for social bubbles and gatherings -meeting outdoors in a group of up to 6 people with those you do not live with, but you should do this while observing social distancing guidelines and keeping at least 2 metres apart. Members who live alone may be in a social bubble with another household and may meet outside subject to social distancing.
- When leaving the club, please exit via the concert room using the fire door – see layout plan
