Trial Site & Information

The show site is indoors on packed dirt. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies, & water for your dog.

Please note: There will be no spectator chairs in the main arena for seating. Spectator seating in the stands only.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring. Exercise and toilet your dog in designated areas. Please poop and scoop and use garbage containers on the site. Please be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.

A warm up jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Trial Site Rules

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement

This is a NON SMOKING inside of the building or near the doors.

No alcohol on the premises as per the rental agreement of the facility.

Directions to the Trial Site Route 1: Take

Highway 28 north out of city, take the Cardiff/Sturgeon Agriplex turnoff by turning west (left) onto TWP 554, head towards the residential area, the arena is on the left side of the road immediately right after the train tracks. **Route 2:** Take HWY 2 north, take the Cardiff turnoff heading east (right) on TWP 554, drive past the Golf Club, the arena is on the right side just before the train tracks.

About UKI Agility

Speedstakes Titling Program

SS Beginners: For dogs that are not eligible for SS Novice, SS Senior and SS Champion levels in the Speed Stakes Program.

SS Novice: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points in the SS Beginners classes. Or a newly registered dog who is eligible for Beginners, but the owner/handler currently runs a Champ level dog in the International Program.

SS Senior: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 20 points in the SS Novice classes.

SS Champion: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 36 points in the SS Senior classes.

International Titling Program

Beginners: For dogs that are not eligible for Novice, Senior and Champion levels in the International Program

Novice: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points, where 8 of those points must be obtained in agility classes. Or a newly registered dog who is eligible for Beginners, but the owner/handler currently runs a Champ level dog in the International Program.

Senior: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 20 points in the Novice classes, where 12 of those points must be obtained in agility classes, 4 from jumping, and 4 from games.

Champion: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 36 points, where 12 of those points must be obtained in agility classes, 12 from jumping, and 12 from games.

Dogs are measured while in a standing position on a flat surface. The measurement is taken from the top of the dog's withers. All dogs, except the 24 & 22 inch divisions and the 20inch Select, must have an official measurement when at their first show. If your official dog's measurement moves you into a different height than the one entered, you must notify the show secretary and your dog will be moved.

Based on highest STANDARD Agility level at time of Handler UKI registration. After this time, All new dogs that have not competed at any listed organization at time of UKI registration are only eligible for Beginners with exception to Amendment June 1, 2015 unless that handler is currently competing with a International Program Champ level dog under their account, then the dog must start in Novice. All new dogs registered after Handler registration may only transfer at the level they were competing at on the date of the Handler registration. Once a dog is registered with UKI, then no other organizations results have bearing on the dog's level with UKI.

Canadian Open 2019: Aug 29 - Sept 2, William M. Sobey Indoor Sports Complex, Nova Scoti

Qualifying period – July 9 2018 & ends July 7, 2019. Qualifying scores must be gained in the height you will run at the Canadian Open. The same dog and handler team that gains the scores below can only run the events at the Open.

WAO tryout: To try out for the 2019 WAO team, you must run the Open events at the WAO height you will be trying out for.

UKI Masters Series Final: Individual Winners of the Masters Series Agility & Jumping classes or Overall placements described below qualify for the Masters Final at the Canadian Open. If you do not qualify at a local Masters Heat, there will be a last chance heat at the Canadian Open. Canadian Masters Final qualification must be from a Canadian Trial only.

UKI Canadian Nationals – To earn a bye into Round 2 the dog and handler must obtain **3 clear Agility Rounds**, **2 clear Jumping rounds**, **1 clear Speedstakes round and 2 qualifying games rounds** from the current level the dog is working at from any UKI Trial in Canada & USA within the qualifying period. Clear Masters Agility and Jumping rounds may be used. (Nursery does not apply. Games rounds can from any two of the following classes: Snooker, Power & Speed, Snakes & Ladders and Gamblers.

Masters Series Tournament Rules 2018

The aim of the Masters Series is to encourage more competitive running in UKI classes and improve the overall standard of top level agility. The Masters has been created for dogs and competitors whose goal is to compete at both National and International level.

- The Masters is considered one class made up of 2 rounds: an Agility and Jumping round with results combined.
 Entry open to ALL dogs.
- Separate competition for each jump height.
- Running order for Agility will be in reverse order of Jumping results.
 Cumulative scoring; dog with the lowest score wins.
- Faults converted into seconds (5 faults = 5 seconds) and time faults treated the same as course faults but converted on a 1:1 ratio.
 Winners in each height of the Agility round and the Jumping round qualify for the Masters Series Final.
- If 1-5 dogs are entered in a jump height 1st & 2nd place from the combined scores of Agility and Jumping rounds qualify for the Masters Series Final. If 5 10 dogs are entered in a jump height 1st 3rd will qualify, above 10; 1st 4th will qualify. Prize money to be paid out to at each heat for the combined winners per the prize fund below. In the event of a tie for the combined results, the result from the Agility round will be the deciding factor. If there is still a tie, the dogs will compete in a run-off on the 2nd rounds course.
- Eliminations will result in 100 faults with a 60-second course time.
- Dogs that score 320 cumulative and over will not be placed nor awarded prize money.
- A no-show in either class will result in a disqualification from the class (this means that both classes will have no score) and therefore will not be eligible prizes and awards or eligibility to qualify for the Final.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

UK Agility International Rules and Regulations apply to the whole event and all people and dogs must comply with these at all times. As a competitor it is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations as they stand at the time of the show. This show will run under the 3rd Edition UK Agility International rules.

All dogs and handlers must be registered with UK Agility International in order to compete. UK Agility International's official rules & regulations are given free on registration of Handler/Owner to UKI. If you or your dog is not already registered, fill out the UKI registration form included in this schedule and add the registration fee to your entry fee.

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of **UK Agility International rules and regulations** including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete in UK Agility International Trials, with the exception of dogs over 15 calendar months of age eligible to compete in Speedstakes.

Entries without fees paid in full will be returned. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or Guardian if the competitor is a minor. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees. If you use a recorded delivery service, you must specify No Signature Required.

Refund Policy Entries will not be accepted, changed or altered after the closing date except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A late fee of \$10/dog's entries may be charged. Once a show has been closed refunds of any kind for any reason will not be available. A partial refund may be available for injuries where a veterinarian note is provided. Contact the show management for details, NOT UKI.

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition without refund if it is: suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, interfering with the safety of any person or other animal or if it is likely to cause itself damage or suffering if it continues competing.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn and neither in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal providing this was within accordance of UK Agility International rules and regulations.

It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Handlers working more than one dog in a class **must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn**. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

It is expressly understood that **Competitors alone are responsible** for the behavior of their dogs, children and guests. Any competitor whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the show management, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, guests from the event grounds. No refunds of fees will be made in such a case.

No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.

Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the show management reserves the right to appoint another judge. Should circumstances so dictate the show manager, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to UK Agility International. In the event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond our control, the SHOW MANAGEMENT may defray such expenses from the entry fee to cover the cost of the show preparation. These accounts will then be made public.

All competitors MUST clean up after their dogs at all times. Failure to do so will result in competitors being asked to leave the Show.

Dogs left in hot cars, or dogs appearing to be in distress, will be dealt with as seen fit by the Show Management.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. **There will be a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks**. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made before a competitor may compete. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls to a UK Agility International account must be paid prior to the start of the event. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice shall be reported to UK Agility International. UK Agility International will suspend a dog's/handlers registration until fees are paid in full. If your UK Agility International account owes money when we process the entries for this show your running orders may be withheld to encourage you to visit Show Manager at the show so that the account balance can be resolved.

All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken the show management will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.

Bitches in season may run at this show. You must notify the show secretary as early as possible to this fact. All BIS must use a mat on the start line, to be provided by the show. In season pants may be worn while running but handlers allow this at their own risk. Dogs will run in order as printed on the running order.

Entry into this show acknowledges that all competitors are required to volunteer.

TBYB will allow you to enter your first UKI trial and pay for that Entry either online or by sending a check, and if after your first UKI trial, you would like to keep your membership with UKI, payment for registration will be due 7 working days after that trial and must be paid online in \$USD.
