Application and Closing Dates:

All applications must be made on the official form and returned to the Trophy Officer by 30th October. The awards or points submitted must be gained within the Club's financial year ie. 1st October to 30th September the following year.

**Please note: Any other titles gained and not listed here, but recognized by the ANKC, will be eligible to be included. Points will be allocated based on level of difficulty.*

Results and Presentation:

All results will be announced and trophies presented at the Annual Weimfest Christmas Fun Day.

Ruling Body:

The Committee's decision on all trophies is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Trophy Ownership and their Return:

All perpetual trophies, which are awarded annually, remain the property of the Weimaraner Club of Victoria Inc. All holders of perpetual trophies must return such trophies to the Trophy Officer in clean and good condition by 30th of October.

Eligible Breeds:

Both the Weimaraner and Weimaraner Long Hair Breeds are eligible to apply for perpetual trophy awards.

Note: Within these rules the wording "Weimaraner" is to apply to both breeds.
