IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DAY OF SCREENING

DO not walk your dog prior to exam, full bladders will provide the best images.

1. For the best quality images, Scotties must have a shaved belly area. The technician can shave your dog on the day of however, you may also do it at home. No skirt needs to be shaved.
 2. All dogs to be screened must be CURRENT on Rabies vaccine and you must be able to produce the tag or certificate from veterinarian.
 3. The US technician may not discuss any findings or images. A report will be emailed to you within 48 hours of the screening
 4. All results will be in the report and in the images on the flash drive.
 5. You will be given a flash-drive containing the images to take to your vet.
 6. You will crate out of your car until it is your turn. Volunteers will be there to escort you to the signup sheet and give you a number to display on your windshield. Participants will be called by number in order of registration/arrival on site. Volunteers will call you when it is your turn and meet you at the door and take your dog to be scanned. There will be an entrance door and a separate exit door. A volunteer will meet you at the exit when your dog has been scanned.
 7. Due to Covid19 restrictions all social distancing measures will be observed and masks are required both inside the building and when speaking outside with the volunteers.
