Mezzanine Gallery Exhibition Prospectus

The Hammond Regional Arts Center (HRAC) is expanding their connection to the visual arts community with the introduction of the Mezzanine Gallery. The Mezzanine Gallery will serve as an exhibition space for emerging artists who are interested in exploring avenues within the art world.

Eligibility

The Hammond Regional Arts Center invites passionate artists aged 18+ to apply to showcase their work in the Mezzanine Gallery space. In order to be considered for exhibition, artists must become members of Hammond Regional Arts Center. Annual memberships are only \$15 for students and \$30 for individuals, and are available to purchase on the website, www.hammondarts.org.

Submission

If interested, artists must fill out a formal proposal with a minimum of 5 images of work (in PDF format), along with an artist statement. All of which should be emailed to Kacie Sanders, the Mezzanine Gallery Coordinator, at artistsmezzanine@hammondarts.org. Once submitted, artist portfolios/proposals will be reviewed by the Hammond Regional Art Center's Gallery Committee.

Deadlines/Important Dates

Deadlines for submissions are the 15th of each month. The Gallery Committee meets on the 3rd week of the month. Once a decision has been made, selected artists will then be notified by the Mezzanine Gallery Coordinator by the last day of that month.

Installation

Work must arrive ready to install (i.e. 2-D works must be WIRED and ready to hang; 3-D works ready to place). HRAC staff will be responsible for exhibition layout, lighting, and basic installation. In cases where artwork exceeds basic hanging (2-D) and/or placement (3-D), artists may be called upon to assist in installation. It is the responsibility of the artist to communicate and provide any special installation needs, including: instructions, tools, equipment, etc.

** Artists are not required to hang their own work for the Mezzanine BUT the artist must work with the Mezzanine Gallery Coordinator during the installation process. **

AGREEMENT TO TERMS

Submission of work(s) by an artist indicates full agreement to the terms laid out in this prospectus. Any questions or concerns regarding this document must be discussed prior to submission. In the event that an artist is selected for exhibition, artists are expected to cooperate fully. Further agreements in the form of a completed and signed contract will be required for acceptance and display of work(s) to be finalized.

**All work exhibited in the Mezzanine Gallery will be for sale, Hammond Region Arts Center will take a 35% commission in the event that work is sold.
