AMAZING IRELAND, 2021 ITINERARY

June 25th – Depart from Charlotte on overnight flight to Dublin. We can help make arrangements from other airports if need be.

June 26th – On arrival in Dublin we will be met by Owen Mohan, our knowledgeable and entertaining Irish driver/guide. The early arrival provides a full day to begin our Irish experience, taking in the culture, history, and music of The Emerald Isle - a place of great antiquity, great fun, and as you will discover home to wonderful Irish hospitality. **Guaranteed early check-in. Enjoy breakfast** and then relax or go and explore. Our first stay is at Killashee Hotel in Killashee. From the Victorian grandeur of the Original House, to the acres of splendid gardens and gloriously wild woodland and trails, there are so many hidden places to explore. Welcome to Ireland session at our hotel tonight.

Overnight: Killashee Hotel, Killashee (B)

June 27th – After breakfast depart Killashee. Along the way to Galway, we will stop in at the legendary Tullamore D.E.W. Visitor Center to tour the facility, see how the “Water of Life” is made, and enjoy a tasting of this fine Irish Whiskey. We will stop for lunch in the beautiful riverside town of Athlone, before we continue to Clonmacnoise – a monastic settlement founded in 544 and a wonderful collection of stone ruins that is sure to bring to mind the Ireland of Saints and Scholars. Later this evening in Galway, we will enjoy a private concert with the legendary musician Carmel Dempsey.

Overnight: Jurys Inn, Galway (B, D)

June 28th – Following another “full Irish” breakfast we will experience the dramatic sights and natural beauty of the Sky Road along the Wild Atlantic Way through the rugged Connemara Region. We will include a stop at the exquisite Kylemore Abbey and a then on to the Connemara Heritage & History Center. This family-run center is packed full of local history and culture. Hear legends from the region that remains largely unchanged from the time of “The Great Hunger” and get a charming glimpse into life as it was long ago. The craft shop stocks locally made knitwear and artworks. We continue our tour of the peninsula passing Ireland’s only fjord, glimpse mussel “farming” as we make our way to Westport. Westport is nestled safe at the foot of towering and legendary Croagh Patrick – still a pilgrim sight to this day - overlooking Clew Bay and its enchanting islands – one for each day of the year. Following check in, enjoy time on your own to discover why The Irish Times in 2020 voted Westport one of the “Best Places to Live” in Ireland. Then return to the hotel for fine dining and another fun-filled evening of music.

Overnight: Wyatt Hotel, Westport (B, D)

June 29th – Much of the landscape of Sligo inspired the the poetry of W.B. Yeats and the poet is buried, as he wished, in a simple church-yard in Drumcliffe, just north of Sligo town. After breakfast we will make a stop at **Yeats’s Grave**. We also plan on visiting the **Carrowmore Megalithic Cemetery**. The origins of these monuments reach far into prehistory – the most ancient among them is close to 6,000 years old.

Overnight: Mill Park Hotel, Donegal (B)

June 30th – After breakfast we will start our return journey to Dublin City as we first stop in at the **Belleek Pottery Visitor Centre**. Here we will learn how the famous pottery is made and marvel at the craftsmanship of the artist creating the legendary and delicate table-ware. Established in 1857 Belleek Pottery holds a very special place in the cultural and commercial heritage of County Fermanagh and is one of the island of Ireland’s top visitor attractions. We will also stop in Lisnaskea in County Fermanagh & The Woolen Mill Shop for a view into how those beautiful seaters, blankets, and more come to be. Next, we will stop in Trim to visit Trim Castle, an outstanding example of the type of structure from this time – perhaps you’ve seen Trim in her “staring role” in the movie “Braveheart”. Upon arrival into Dublin City, our driver will provide a tour of the Irish Capital and point out some of her more popular and historic sights as we drive by elegant Georgian squares and houses, colorful parks, and bustling shopping areas.

Overnight: Camden Court Hotel, Dublin (B)

July 1 – Today is dedicated to the bustling fair city of Dublin, an amazing combination of ancient Viking settlement to modern and busy European capital. For many, the highlight of the day will be our tour of the very popular **Guinness Storehouse** where we can explore exhibits and over 250 years of innovation in brewing and marketing “the black stuff”. The tour ends in the Gravity Bar, the highest bar in Ireland, with a pint of Guinness and a great 360-degree view of Dublin. Farewell to Ireland session at our hotel tonight.

Overnight: Camden Court Hotel (B, D)

July 2nd – Arrive Dublin Airport with time for last minute Duty-Free shopping before return flight home. **(B)**
