Her love for music, theatre and dance grew into her involvement with local bands, community theatre troupes and choirs, from which she received multiple vocal competition and theatre awards.

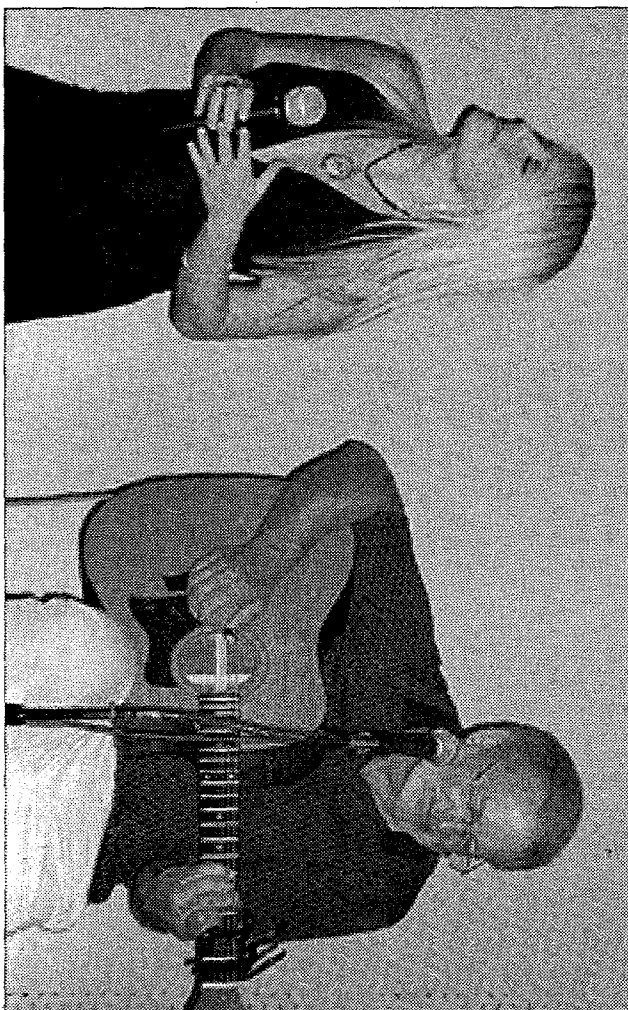
Only recently, however, was Reign coaxed out of her 'day job' as a management consultant to share her many talents.

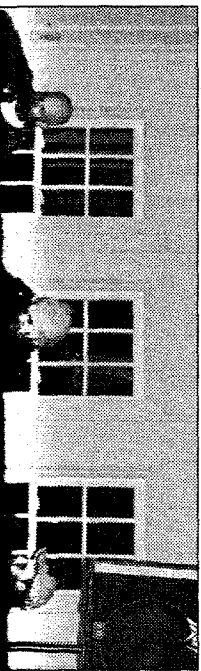
