

Award-winning Country Artist Returns Home to Bring Hope to Cancer Patients

Reading native Angela Reign's "Hope Reigns Tour" August 24-25 To Benefit Cancer Support Community

When Atlanta's Angela Reign - who recently was named the Georgia Music Awards 2013 Female Country Artist of the Year - returns to her hometown of Cincinnati August 24 and 25, it will be an especially meaningful homecoming for the Reading native. "I wanted to do something to honor my cousin, Jeff Hurt, and how tenaciously he's battled cancer, so I'm headed home for two performances dedicated to the Cancer Support Community (CSC, formerly The Wellness Community) where he and thousands of other people in Greater Cincinnati dealing with cancer have found support for their fight," explained Ms. Reign. The "Hope Reigns Tour" will feature two concerts: Saturday, August 24 at Toby Keith's I Love This Bar and Grill at the Banks beginning at 9pm (\$5 cover) and Sunday, August 25 at the Taste of Blue Ash Main Stage beginning at 5pm where she will open for country star Rodney Atkins (free).

Ms. Reign and her band will donate \$1,000 to Cancer Support Community from the "Hope Reigns Tour" and she encourages their fans to also support the non-profit organization with donations. "I have been so impressed by the programs offered by CSC to help people with cancer and their families fight through this frightening disease," explained Ms. Reign. "I am especially proud to support them financially because they provide all of their programs and services completely free of charge, which is so important when families are facing lots of medical bills and often a loss of income due to cancer."
