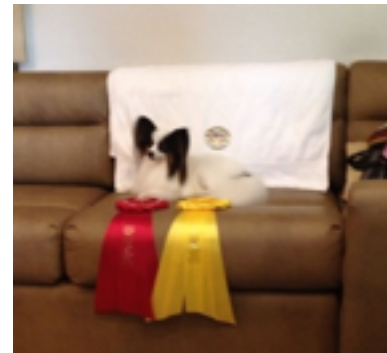

Washoe County Animal Ordinance changes update: Item 22. The Interim Director of Washoe County Regional Animal Services, Kevin Schiller, updated the Board on the process for proposed changes to the animal control ordinance regarding dangerous dogs, puppy mills, retail sales of animals and other topics. Changes have been made to Nevada animal laws the past two legislative sessions, requiring the County to amend Washoe County's animal regulations. On July 15, Washoe County hosted a public meeting to inform the community about the process to change the code. Topic-specific public workshops to start drafting animal code changes will be held August 25 and 27 at 5:30 p.m. at the Wilbur D. May Center. "Our goal is to provide the public with a great opportunity to have their voices heard regarding animal code draft changes," said Schiller. "Between now and August 18, we want the community to email us or go to our online portal and give us feedback."
