The **Greg Sover Band** will be returning to **Steel City Coffee House** in Phoenixville, PA for the first time since April of this year. The band expects a packed house after a triumphant performance at Phoenixville Blues Festival on Saturday, for which the band got a standing ovation and was given an encore. After the band's set there were brisk sales of Sover's CD *Songs of a Renegade* and new fans were lined up at the stage for Sover's autograph. We recommend that fans purchase tickets at Steel City in advance for this show.

In light of the devastation due to Hurricane Harvey and Hurricane Irma, the Greg Sover Band will donate the net proceeds from ticket sales and all money collected from CD sales at Steel City to the American Red Cross to support the relief efforts.

"I saw Houston under water and people's homes destroyed and I just couldn't sit back and do nothing. I want to help," said Greg Sover.

The band will also be recording the Steel City show for possible release. It will be their first official live recording session and we're encouraging fans to come to the show.

"I'm really excited about recording our show at Steel City because it's one of our favorite places to perform," said Sover. "It will be our first live recording and I'm looking forward to our fans being with us."

This year the band has begun to get airplay across the U.S. and internationally. An astounding eight of the ten songs on ***Songs of a Renegade*** have gotten airplay. And great reviews are coming in for ***Songs of a Renegade*** and the band's dynamic live performances. This is some of what's being said:

The Greg Sover Band will return to Phoenixville for a third time this month to compete in a competition sponsored by the Steel City Blues Society, the sponsor of the Phoenixville Blues Festival (no connection to Steel City Coffeehouse). The winner of the competition, which will be held at the Great American Pub in Phoenixville on September 29th, will represent the Steel City Blues Society at the International Blues Challenge in Memphis in January, 2018.

The band has also begun to record the follow-up to ***Songs of a Renegade*** with a planned release date of early 2018. They're also looking forward to shows this fall and more extensive touring next year.
