The **Greg Sover Band** will be returning to **Steel City Coffee House** in Phoenixville, PA for the first time since April of this year. The band will be recording the event for possible release. It will be their first official live recording session and we're encouraging fans to come to the show.

The band burst onto the Philadelphia music scene in 2016 with the release of their debut CD ***Songs of a Renegade***. Performances at Philadelphia's World Cafe Live and Hard Rock Cafe, Sellersville Theater, Puck in Doylestown and several outdoor concerts in the area, as well as support from Philadelphia's renowned noncommercial radio station WXPN, have led to increased popularity.

"I'm really excited about recording our show at Steel City because it's one of our favorite places to perform," said Sover. "It will be our first live recording and I'm looking forward to our fans being with us."

This year the band has begun to get airplay across the U.S. and internationally. An astounding eight of the ten songs on ***Songs of a Renegade*** have gotten airplay. The band has begun to record the follow-up to ***Songs of a Renegade*** with a planned release date of early 2018. The band is also looking forward to shows this fall and more extensive touring next year.

Opening for the Greg Sover Band will be **Northern Lights**. Northern Lights features the dynamic duo of Raquel Rosenwald and Ayva Behm. They perform a unique blend of indie and alternative music. Rosenwald has played guitar, bass and drums since a young age, earning numerous jazz guitar awards. She even records and mixes her own music. Behm has been studying piano and performing in recitals since the age of six, later exploring composition, singing and guitar. The duo originated from the suburbs of Philadelphia and has been writing, recording and performing since 2014. For this performance they will be joined by Michael Gisli and Victor Rosenwald.
