Another month of singing and praying. So many of you have been great about praying for my friend Donna Kay and her record producer husband Mark Moseley. Mark is in a good living situation now in assisted living. He could use an electric wheel chair, but he says he wants the manual one to keep the strength in his right arm since the left is completely immobile.

Donna Kay is another story. I went to all the doctors' appointments with her in planning her treatments. Then she had chemotherapy and radiation 5 days a week for 6 weeks. Then there was no more they could do. She has gotten weaker, more tired, unable to care for herself, and gotten that terrible kind of confusion where she doesn't know she's confused. She's sure that there's work she should be doing, somewhere she should be, something everyone else knows that she doesn't know. She started hospice care yesterday. All of us are heartbroken. Thank you for your many prayers.

Getting to travel and sing in the middle of this has been so healing for me and of course, makes me even more grateful for being able to do the things I can do. Since MCC is celebrating its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary through this year, Rev. Curtis Smith was kind enough to include me in the celebration at Trinity MCC in Arlington, TX.

I was totally treated like royalty. They flew me in and put me up in a lovely hotel. But the ministry time was so fruitful that you could tell how much healing and teaching has already gone on, so the field was ready for harvest. I had some wonderful time sharing with a counselor at a local AIDS clinic, a man whose husband has recently died, and one who came to the Lord at Calvary Chapel close to the time that I did and knew some of the same people from

Cindy and I have a little different take on that. I do tithe to fully inclusive Christian ministries, like Encounter Missions International and The Reformation Project, and Brentwood United Methodist church knew that before I we joined there. But, like Romans 10:14 says (in the Message), "How can they hear if nobody tells them?" And sometimes, you know, SHOW them. So, when they asked Cindy and me to do all the music for the women's retreat we prayed about it and felt it was where we should be.

Some of you remember that Cindy dusted off her guitar and took some lessons when I was struggling with playing, so we were ready to lead some singalongs and share some songs we've written together. And at the Bible study I attend, they announced that "Marsha and her wife" would be doing the music, and friends from Cindy's mission trips told others that "CJ and her wife" (that's what they call her at church) would be there. All in all, we had a wonderful time and I have to feel we were right where we were supposed to be. The big worldwide United Methodist conference is coming in February. I have been to all the meetings to speak on behalf of our community, but only your prayers will ultimately change their hearts.
